THE PROGRAM

LE FRANÇAIS PRATIQUE is a complete teaching series which combines readers, student *cahiers*, teacher's guides, and audio-cassettes. While the readers can be used quite independently, each additional part of the program enhances, enriches and reinforces the original material. OBJECTIVE

LE FRANÇAIS PRATIQUE offers students a richness of language to assist them in developing fluency in social and practical situations unique to their milieu. THE CAHIER DE L'ÉLÈVE

The *cahier de l'élève*, in its simplicity and variety, encourages and motivates students to complete the exercises on their own. Each title per series offers several exercises for each of the following activities:

J'écoute: used in conjunction with the tapes, assists in comprehension, pronunciation, and differentiation of problem sounds.

J'écris: questions, scrambled sentences
Je pratique: crosswords, anagrams, word relationships, and hidden words.

Épreuve: true / false questions, phrase matches, rebuses.

THE TEACHER'S GUIDES

The teacher's guides feature a variety of activities to exploit each theme. The teacher's guides are a vital component of the program. They are designed especially to ease students painlessly and enjoyably into facility of expression and expansion of vocabulary in thematic real-life situations. French class becomes an enjoyable, stimulating experience, as students are absorbed in participation, competition, challenge, awareness of other cultures, and exchange of ideas. The varied activities for each book in the series include word games, board games, writing activities, group and pair activities, cultural insights, and drama.

Each Teacher's Guide features the following:

- Warm-up activities: listening, writing, and speaking to review known vocabulary.
- Board activities: games and conversation emphasizing the structural focus of each theme.
- Writing activities: games, grammatical reinforcement, mix and match.
- Group activities (pairs and large groups): thematic games and skits.

- Dramatic activities: thematic surveys, skits, and scavenger hunts.
